2013 / 2014 School Council Annual Report

The RPPS School Council acts as a liaison between the parent / guardian community, the school staff, and the OCDSB. The Council meets once a month during the school year, on the second Tuesday of every month in the school library, from 7pm to 9pm.

During the 2013 / 2014 school year, the Council accomplished the following items (amounts are approximate):

Fundraising

- raised ~\$16,000 from the sale of pizza to students on Fridays
- raised ~ \$8,000 from Dance-A-Thon
- raised ~ \$5,000 from the sale of milk to students during lunch
- raised ~ \$2,500 from other events (Fundscrip, hot dog day, clothing sales, directories)
- received \$30,000 from Book Fair proceeds

Facilities Enhancement

invested \$700 on the garden

Nutrition Programs

operated the milk and pizza programs

Curriculum Enhancement

- invested \$1500 in classroom workshops
- invested \$3,000 in dance program (Tradansa)
- invested \$3,500 in physical education workshop (Aussie-X)
- invested \$2,000 in teacher enrichments (allowance for teachers to use on whatever they need in the classroom)
- invested \$ 17,000 in technology (projectors, white board, wireless keyboards and mounting)
- invested \$3,000 in sports equipment and events
- invested \$4,000 in library enhancements

Community Building

- coordinated with the RPL and RPA in the ongoing maintenance of the soccer field (and contributed our \$2,000 share towards the maintenance)
- spent \$1,500 on a free BBQ for the entire school community

elected a full council for the 2013 / 2014 school year

Strengthening Public Education

- spent \$4,000 on subsidizing field trips (bus fees)
- spent \$10,000 on the grade 6 annual trip and graduation to Montreal

- had a presentation by a representative of the Advisory Committee on the Arts
- hosted Pino Buffone at a Council meeting to speak to parents about the math curriculum
- in collaboration with the teaching staff hosted a Math Night to educate and engage parents on the math curriculum
- applied for a PRO grant for a Speaker Series
- provided education and outreach on the OSTA Proposed Bell Time Change (survey, discussions at meetings, information sheet, email updates and reminders of public consultation)
- developed a Funding Request Form for proposed Council supported expenditures
